



## Map of Edgar Felix Bike Path


## Wall Township

### Bicycle Tour

All mileage is from where the bike path starts at Hospital Road, heading east toward Manasquan.



- A 0.0 Western terminus at Hospital Rd.  
Parking for 4 cars or more.
- 0.3 Bridge over the Garden State Pkwy
- 0.7 Cross West Side Dr. Allenwood school is 0.1 miles down the road to the right.
- B 0.9 Allenwood General Country Store.  
Food Establishment and Antiques.  
Cross Allenwood Lakewood Rd.  
Park and Gazebo with parking.  
Allenwood Station across street.  
Gift Shop.
- 1.0 Cross Ramshorn Road
- 1.6 Pass under Route 34
- 2.9 Pass under Route 35
- 3.0 Access from Philadelphia Ave.  
Parking for 30 cars.
- C Orchard Park – Lighted Tennis Courts, Ball Diamond, Basketball and Playground.
- 3.0 Optional: Path left to Pennsylvania Ave.
- D 3.6 Eastern terminus at Main St. in Manasquan, is across from the municipal lot.  
The Manasquan business district is 0.1 miles down Main Street to the right. (Restaurants and stores.)  
Continue down Main Street for 1.5 miles to get to the beach.



### Directions:

To the Hospital Rd. Terminus (Point A): Take Garden State Pkwy Exit 98 to Route 34 South. Take right at first light onto Allenwood Rd. following the signs to Allaire State Park. In 0.7 miles, turn right on Atlantic Avenue, at a T stop sign. In 0.3 miles, turn left on Hospital Rd. The bike path will be on your left in 0.2 miles. It is a non-motorized asphalt path.

To the Manasquan End (Point D): Take Rt. 35 to Atlantic Ave. at circle. Head east on Atlantic toward Manasquan (the Shore). In 0.7 miles after the circle, turn right on Main St. The bike path will be on your right in 0.1 miles, with parking on your left.

“Wall Township is a 30.6 square mile suburban municipality located in the southeastern corner of Monmouth County.

Wall Township was incorporated on March 7, 1851, by an act of the New Jersey Legislature that separated it from Howell Township. The township is named after Senator Garret Dorset Wall, who served in both the New Jersey Legislature and the United States Senate. He was also elected by the Legislature to serve as Governor, but “General Wall” declined the honor.”

The Edgar Felix Bike Path is part of what originated as the Freehold and Jamesburg Agricultural Railroad in the 1800’s. When fully built, it ran from Monmouth Junction, went right through the Jamesburg business district, then through Freehold, Farmingdale, Allenwood, and Manasquan. The road eventually became part of the Penn Central System. The portion east of Farmingdale was abandoned by the Penn Central and sold to Jersey Central Power and Light, which sold it to Wall Township.

The Felix Bike Path was developed on the section from Hospital Road to Main Street in Manasquan in 1971 and 1972. The remainder, toward Farmingdale, is mostly within the boundaries of Allaire State Park, but is not improved.

### Attractions:

If you continue west on Atlantic Ave., past Hospital Rd., you come to **Allaire State Park**, a restored 19<sup>th</sup> century iron plantation, now known as “**Allaire Village**.” This historic park has been preserved and restored by the State of New Jersey. They host the **Pine Creek Railroad** which runs short steam train excursions. **Spring Meadow Golf Course** is just before Allaire State Park.

Further west is the **Manasquan Reservoir**, in Howell, which includes a five-mile loop recreational trail that circles the lake.
