

**TOWNSHIP OF WALL**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 21- 1995**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A CERTIFICATION PROHIBITING THE USE OF EXCESSIVE FORCE AND A CERTIFICATION PROHIBITING THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR LOBBYING.**

**WHEREAS**, certain Federal funds are potentially available to Monmouth County through the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has allocated funding to the County in the amount of \$3,960,000.00 for Fiscal Year 1995; and

**WHEREAS**, the County is making some of these funds available to certain participating municipalities and non-profit agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, it is required that the Township of the Wall executed a project agreement with Monmouth County to undertake a project known as "Upgrade Youth Services Facility"; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is requiring that the Mayor or other Chief Executive Officer of the Township of Wall sign additional certifications in order to receive these funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Wall has adopted a policy prohibiting the use of excessive force by its law enforcement agency (police force) within its jurisdiction against any individuals engaged in non-violent civil rights demonstrations; and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of that policy is attached to and made part of this

ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, that the Township of Wall has met the conditions of receiving a FY 1994 CDBG allocation by adopting a policy prohibiting the use of excessive force and by not using Federal Funds for lobbying or by disclosing that funds have been used for lobbying.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that the Mayor of the Township of Wall is hereby authorized to sign the attached certifications which will become a part of the FY 1995 project agreement.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its publication according to law.

#### **NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on September 13, 1995 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall Township, New Jersey on September 27, 1995 at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, to the members of the general public who shall request same.
