

TOWNSHIP OF WALL  
ORDINANCE NO. 4 1995

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE WALL TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION, PROVIDING FOR THE JOINT PURCHASING OF GOODS, SUPPLIES, AND SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall and the Wall Township Board of Education both serve the Wall Township community; and

WHEREAS, the taxpayers of the Township benefit from any savings or reduction in expenditures by either the Township or the Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, there are various goods, materials and supplies which are utilized by both the Board of Education and Township offices and departments; and various work and services which are performed on behalf of both the Township and the Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee finds that through a cooperative effort with the Board of Education, joint purchasing arrangements and, where appropriate, joint public bidding for work, materials, supplies or services can result in efficiencies of scale; more cost effective purchasing; and other savings and efficiencies to both public bodies; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-10, the Township is authorized to enter into a joint purchasing agreement with the Wall Township Board of Education providing for the purchase of work, materials, supplies and services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee finds that such a joint purchasing agreement would be in the best interests of the Township and all of its citizens and taxpayers;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The Township Administrator be and is hereby authorized to continue discussions with the Wall Township Board of Education and to reach agreement with the Board of Education on joint purchasing arrangements for such work, materials, supplies and services which may be the subject of joint public bidding or purchasing so as to result in cost savings to the taxpayers of the Township.

Section 2. The Mayor and Township Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Joint Purchasing Agreement between the Township and the Board of Education, such agreement to be subject to the approval of the Township Administrator and Township Attorney as to form and content.

Section 3. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the forgoing ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on *2/8/95* and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building 2700 Allaire Road, Wall Township, New Jersey, on *2/22/95* at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's office in the Township of Wall, to the members of the general public who shall request same.
