

TOWNSHIP OF WALL
ORDINANCE NO. 16 - 1994

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AMENDING CHAPTER XIII, "FIRE PREVENTION", OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977", AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, PERTAINING TO ENFORCEMENT OF THE UNIFORM FIRE SAFETY ACT AND FEES CHARGED THEREUNDER.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter XIII, "Fire Prevention" of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, Section 13-3, "Uniform Fire Safety Act", be and the same is hereby amended and supplemented by the addition thereto of the following subsection:

"13-3.7. Fees; Inspections. The joint board of fire prevention may from time to time establish fees for permits and inspections, which shall be consistent with the Uniform Fire Safety Act and the regulations adopted by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs thereunder. Such fees and any amendments or modifications thereto, shall be submitted to the Township Committee for its review and consent, and shall take effect only upon the adoption of a Resolution by the Township Committee consenting to the imposition of such fee schedule."

SECTION 2. Chapter XIII, "Fire Prevention", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, Section 13-3, "Uniform Fire Safety Act", be and the same is hereby amended and supplemented by

the addition thereto of the following subsection:

"13-3.8 Enforcement. Any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of the Uniform Fire Safety Act, or the provisions of this chapter; or who shall fail to pay any required fee or permit any required inspection thereunder; or who shall fail to comply with any lawful order of the fire official shall, for each and every such violation or incident of noncompliance, be punished by a fine as stated in Chapter III, Section 3-1. The fire official be and is hereby authorized to issue such summons or summonses as may be appropriate in the municipal court for any such violation."

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Should any section, paragraph, clause, or any other portion of this ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on July 13, 1994 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall Township, New Jersey, on July 27, 1994 at 8:00 p.m., or as

soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's office in the Wall Township Town Hall to the members of the general public who shall request same.
