

TOWNSHIP OF WALL

ORDINANCE NO. 20-1994

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AMENDING CHAPTER III, "REGULATORY ORDINANCES", SECTION 3-16, "DRUG-FREE SCHOOL ZONES", OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977", AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, PERTAINING TO THE WALL PRIMARY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, Chapter III, "Regulatory Ordinances", Section 3-16, "Drug-Free School Zones", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall" establishes a Drug-Free School Zone Map, pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7 providing for substantial minimum mandatory terms of imprisonment for persons convicted of distributing or dispensing controlled dangerous substances within 1,000 feet of a school property; and

WHEREAS, the Wall Township Board of Education has recently determined to utilize the former municipal building on Bedford Corner Lane for kindergarten students, which building will now be known as the Wall Primary School; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee finds that the Drug-Free School Zone Map should be amended to specifically include the Wall Primary School;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Chapter III, "Regulatory Ordinances", Section 3-16.1, "Drug-Free School Zone Map Authorized", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall,

1977", as amended and supplemented, be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented by the deletion of the aforesaid subsection and the substitution therefor of the following:

"3-16.1 Drug-Free School Zone Map Authorized.

Pursuant to the authority of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7, the Drug-free School Zone Map prepared by Glenn R. Gerken, Township Engineer, and dated August 24, 1994, be and the same is hereby approved and adopted as an official finding and record of the location and boundaries of the areas within the township which are used for school purposes and which are owned by, or leased to the Board of Education of the township and of the areas on or within 1,000 feet of such properties."

Section 2. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township

Committee of the Township of Wall on August 24, 1994 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey, on September 7, 1994 at 8:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to, and up to and including, the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's office in the Township of Wall Town Hall to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
