

TOWNSHIP OF WALL  
ORDINANCE NO. 9 -1994

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE WALL YOUTH CENTER TO EXECUTE INTERLOCAL SERVICE AGREEMENTS PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:8A-1 ET SEQ. BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AND THE SEA GIRT AND SPRING LAKE BOARDS OF EDUCATION.

WHEREAS, the Wall Youth Center provides counselling and educational programs in the areas of substance abuse and awareness; and

WHEREAS, the Boards of Education of Spring Lake and Sea Girt are desirous to retain the services of the Wall Youth Center to present various educational programs to their students and staff pertaining to substance abuse during the 1993 and 1994 school year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et seq. agreements should be prepared to govern the rights and obligations of the Wall Youth Center and the Spring Lake and Sea Girt Boards of Education in connection with such educational programs,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The Director of the Wall Youth Center be and is hereby authorized to execute Interlocal Service Agreements pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et seq. between the Township of Wall and the Spring Lake and Sea Girt Boards of Education the purposes of providing educational programs in substance abuse to students and staff at the Spring Lake and Sea Girt elementary schools during the 1993 and 1994 school

year. Copies of said Agreements shall be maintained on file in the Township Clerk's office for public inspection.

Section 2. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgement shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on *April 27, 1994* and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey, on *May 11, 1994* at 8 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to, and up to and including, the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's office in the Township of Wall Town Hall to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
