

## TOWNSHIP OF WALL

## ORDINANCE NO. 1 - 1994

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER XII, "WATER AND SEWER", OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977" AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, PERTAINING TO WATER CONNECTIONS AND TEMPORARY SERVICE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter XII, "Water and Sewer" of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, Section 12-2.2, "Application for Service Connection", be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented by the addition thereto of the following subsection:

"a. The fee for tapping of the water main, installing corporation cock, service pipe to the curbs, curb step and curb box shall be as follows:

<u>Size of Tap</u>	<u>Installation Fee</u>
3/4"	\$ 775.00
1"	\$ 835.00
1-1/2"	\$1,325.00
2"	\$1,650.00
Larger than 2"	To be established by the Superintendent of Public Works in an amount sufficient to cover all costs to the Township, including administrative costs."

SECTION 2. Chapter XII, "Water and Sewer" of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented by the deletion therefrom of Section 12-2.3, "Temporary Connection", and the substitution therefor of the following:

"12-2.3 Temporary Connection. Any person desiring a temporary supply of water shall make application to the water clerk and pay the following fee therefor:

- a. Single family residential structure - \$30.00
- b. Multiple family residential structure - \$30.00 for the first residential unit and \$30.00 for each additional residential unit.
- c. All nonresidential buildings - \$100.00 for the first 10,000 square feet of space and \$30.00 for each additional 5,000 square feet of space.
- d. Bulk water pickup at township water department - Each tank \$5.00 provided, however, that no tank shall exceed 1,000 gallons in capacity."

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Should any section, paragraph, clause, or any other portion of this ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its

passage and publication according to law.
