

## TOWNSHIP OF WALL

ORDINANCE NO. 5 - 1993

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER V, "GENERAL LICENSING", OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977", AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, SECTION 5-4 "JUNK SHOPS AND JUNK DEALERS".

WHEREAS, a license fee for the maintenance and operation of a junk yard is intended to pay for the administrative costs of investigating the applicant and issuing the license; and

WHEREAS, the license fee charged for a junk yard license has not been increased so as to be consistent with the increased costs of providing these services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall in the County of Monmouth, the State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter V, "General Licensing", of The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, Section 5-4, "Junk Shops and Junk Dealers", subsection 5-4.5, "License Fee", be and the same is hereby amended and supplemented by increasing the license fee from the sum of \$50.00 to the sum of \$100.00.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts thereof and consistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency

SECTION 3. Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this ordinance be judged by a Court of

competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not effect or impair the remainder of the ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing ordinance was introduced and passes on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on Feb. 23, 1993 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall Township, New Jersey, on March 9, 1993 at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's office in the Township of Wall, Town Hall, to the members of the general public who shall request same.
