

TOWNSHIP OF WALL  
ORDINANCE NO. 9 - 1992

AN ORDINANCE TO FIX THE COMPENSATION OF OFFICERS IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township of Wall in the County of Monmouth in the State of New Jersey as follows:

Section I. Unless otherwise noted, the yearly compensation salaries and wages of various officers in the Police Department shall be paid every two (2) weeks in lieu of all fees as follows:

Group I - Superior Officers

Section 2. A listing of the exact salaries for each employee based on the above referenced grades and ranks shall be on file in the office of the Township Administrator and Personnel Coordinator.

Section 3. The salaries above mentioned shall be effective and payable retroactive to January 1, 1992.

Section 4. The above cited salaries shall not be paid until such time as a valid contract has been executed between the Township of Wall and the Superior Officer's Association and the Township of Wall and PBA Local 234.

Section 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part thereof are hereby repealed as to the conflicting portion or portions.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect when passed and published according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on June 10, 1992 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Wall at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey on June 24, 1992 at 8 p.m. at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's office in the Township of Wall Municipal Building to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
