

TOWNSHIP OF WALL
ORDINANCE NO. 4 - 1989

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER II "ADMINISTRATION OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977", AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR AN OFFICIAL HOLIDAY FOR THE DAY AFTER THANKSGIVING AND DELETING GENERAL ELECTION DAY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey:

Section 1. Chapter II "Administration" subsection 2-4.6e "Holidays" of the "Revised General Ordinance of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented be and the same is hereby deleted and supplemented by the following:

e. Holidays

1. The official holidays for all Township employees except police department personnel shall be:

New Year's Day

Martin Luther King's Birthday

Washington's Birthday

Lincoln's Birthday

Good Friday

Memorial Day

Independence Day

Labor Day

Columbus Day

Veterans Day

Thanksgiving Day

The Day after Thanksgiving Day

Christmas Day

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on January 25, 1989 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Wall at the Municipal Courtroom, Police Headquarters Building, Allaire Road, Township of Wall, on February 15, 1989 at 8:00 P.M. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the Agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, Township Hall, to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
