

## TOWNSHIP OF WALL

## ORDINANCE NO. 16 - 1989

AN ORDINANCE TO FIX THE COMPENSATION OF PATROLMEN AND DETECTIVES IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH AND THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Unless otherwise noted the yearly compensation salaries and wages of various officers and employees shall be paid every two weeks, in lieu of all fees, as follows:

PROBATIONARY PATROLMAN	\$21,869.72

Section 2. The salaries above mentioned shall be effective and payable as of January 1, 1989.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance, or any part thereof, are hereby repealed as to the conflicting portion or portions.
