

TOWNSHIP OF WALL

ORDINANCE NO. 15 - 1988

A BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING BOND ORDINANCE NO. 9-1987 PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF LAND AND THE RECONSTRUCTION OF WYCKOFF ROAD IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY, FINALLY ADOPTED APRIL 8, 1987.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Section 3.(a) of the Bond Ordinance entitled "A Bond Ordinance Providing For The Acquisition Of Land And The Reconstruction Of Wyckoff Road In And By The Township Of Wall, In The County Of Monmouth, New Jersey, Appropriating \$260,000. Therefor And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$247,000. Bonds Or Notes Of The Township To Finance Part Of The Cost Thereof" finally adopted April 8, 1987, is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows:

"Section 3.(a) The improvement hereby authorized and the purpose for the financing of which the bonds are to be issued is the acquisition of two properties designated on the Tax Map of Wall Township as Block 917, Lot 66.01 and Block 917, Lot 27 and the acquisition of an easement in and along a portion of property known as Block 917, Lot 51, and the reconstruction of Wyckoff Road from Belmar Boulevard to Industrial Road, all as shown on and in accordance with plans and specifications

therefor on file in the Office of the Clerk, which plans are hereby approved."

Section Two. This amending and supplementing Bond Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption as provided by the Local Bond Law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on *March 9, 1988* and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the Court Room, Police Headquarters Building, Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey on *March 23, 1988* at 8:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office on the Township of Wall Town Hall to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
