

TOWNSHIP OF WALL

ORDINANCE NO. 3-2015

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 215 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC TO PROVIDE THAT THE SPEED LIMIT FOR CHURCH STREET IS 30 MILES PER HOUR FOR THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF THE ROADWAY

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall regulates vehicles and traffic by and through Chapter 215 of the Code of the Township of Wall; and

WHEREAS, the Wall Township Police Department has performed an investigation to determine the appropriate speed limit for Church Street, a municipal road, and the investigation concluded that a speed limit reduction from thirty-five (35) to thirty (30) miles per hour was warranted;

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has reviewed the Police Investigation, concurs in the findings, and has certified to the Township that a thirty (30) mile per hour speed limit for the entire length of the roadway has been approved by the engineer after investigation of the circumstances, and appears to the engineer to be in the interest of safety and the expedition of traffic on the public highways, and conforms to the current standards prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, as adopted by the commissioner; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Wall finds that it is in its best interest to adopt an ordinance to amend and supplement Chapter 215 Vehicles and Traffic to provide that the speed limit for the section of Church Street between Route 35 and the Township of Wall/Borough of Manasquan Border is now thirty (30) miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, in the State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 215, Section 48, Schedule XVI: Speed Limits, of the Code of the Township of Wall shall be amended to provide as follows:

Name of Street	Speed Limit (mph)	Limits
Church Street	30	From Route 35 to the Township of Wall/Borough of Manasquan Border

Section 2. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. Should any section, paragraph clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
