
AUTHORIZATION TO TRANSFER BETWEEN APPROPRIATION RESERVES –
N.J.S.A. 40A:4-59

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-59 provides that all unexpended balances carried forward after the close of the fiscal year are available, until lapsed at the close of the succeeding year, to meet specific claims, commitments or contracts incurred during the preceding fiscal year, and allows transfers to be made from unexpended balances to those which are expected to be insufficient during the first three (3) months of the succeeding year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey, (2/3 of the majority of the full membership concurring herein) that transfers between 2022 Budget Appropriation Reserves be made as follows:
