ORDINANCE NO. 23-2015

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL,
IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND
SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 18, ARTICLE II, SECTION 18.7 REGARDING
EXEMPTION FROM PAYMENT OF CERTAIN TOWNSHIP FEES FOR ACTIVE
VOLUNTEER FIRE AND FIRST AID MEMBERS

WHEREAS, the Township Committee, through Chapter 18, Article II, Section 18.7, provides certain incentive benefits to Wall Township active volunteer fire and first aid members in recognition of the contributions made by these individuals to the Township; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes to amend Chapter 18, Article II, Section 18.7, to update and expand certain incentives that benefit active volunteer fire and first aid members; and,

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, in the State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 18, Article II, Fire Companies and First Aid Squad Incentive Benefits is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

18-7 Exemption from payment of certain fees.

A. All active members of any Township fire company or first aid squad shall be entitled to an exemption from payment of the following:

(6) (Delete previous subsection language and replace as indicated) The Township portion of all Construction Department permit fees for a primary residence owned and occupied by the active volunteer member.

(7) (New subsection) The Township Land Use Permit Fees for a primary residence owned and occupied by the active volunteer member.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in such conflict or inconsistent.

Section 3. This Ordinance may be renumbered for codification purposes.

Section 4. In the event that any section, part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unenforceable or invalid by any court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so held unenforceable or invalid.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.
