ORDINANCE NO. 1-2016

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 215-48 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE
REGARDING SPEED RESTRICTIONS TO LIMIT VEHICLE SPEED ALONG THE ENTIRE
LENGTH OF PAYNTER'S ROAD TO 30 MILES PER HOUR**

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall, through adoption of Wall Municipal Code Chapter 215-1 recognizes that Title 39, of the New Jersey State Statutes, applies to certain roadways within the Township of Wall; and, that Wall Township has the prerogative to establish speed limits upon certain municipal roadways; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall, through adoption of Wall Municipal Code Chapter 215-19 recognizes that Wall Township has the prerogative to establish speed limits upon certain municipal roadways and that such speed limits shall apply in both directions and that such speed limits shall be memorialized in Wall Township Municipal Code Chapter 215-48;and,

WHEREAS, the Wall Township Chief of Police has conducted a traffic study and has determined that it is in the best interests of the residents of Wall Township to establish a speed limit along the entire length of Paynter's Road to 30 miles per hour; and,

WHEREAS, the Wall Township Committee has determined that it would be appropriate, proper and in the best interests of the residents of the Township of Wall to amend and supplement Chapter 215-48 of the Township Code to reflect the speed limit on Paynter's Road to be 30 miles per hour; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 215-48 Schedule XVI: Speed Limits, shall be amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 215-48 Schedule XVI: Speed Limits.

| Name of Street | Speed Limit | Limits |
|-----------------------|--------------------|-------------------------|
| Paynter's Road | 30 miles per hour | Along the entire length |

Section 2. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


Section 3. The Mayor, Clerk, and such other Township officials are hereby authorized to take such ministerial actions as are necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.
