

TOWNSHIP OF WALL

ORDINANCE NO. 6-2016

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 215 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC TO RESTRICT PARKING ON SECTIONS OF NEW BEDFORD ROAD, BAILEYS CORNER ROAD AND SCHOOLHOUSE ROAD

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall regulates vehicles and traffic by and through Chapter 215 of the Code of the Township of Wall; and

WHEREAS, the Wall Township Police Department has performed an investigation to determine the appropriate parking restrictions to promote pedestrian and vehicular safety, particularly during large events along sections of New Bedford Road, Baileys Corner Road and Schoolhouse Road, all municipal roads;

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has reviewed the Police Investigation, concurs in the findings, agrees that that the parking restrictions will promote pedestrian and vehicular safety, and generally conforms to the current standards prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, as adopted by the commissioner; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Wall finds that it is in its best interest to adopt an ordinance to amend and supplement Chapter 215 Vehicles and Traffic to restrict parking along certain sections of New Bedford Road, Baileys Corner Road and Schoolhouse Road.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, in the State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 215, Section 33, Schedule I: No Parking, of the Code of the Township of Wall shall be amended to provide as follows:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Sides</u>	<u>Location</u>
New Bedford Road	East	From Ocean Road to Route 35
Baileys Corner Road	Both	From Allaire Road to 18 th Avenue
Schoolhouse Road	Both	From Belmar Boulevard to Neptune Border

Section 2. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


Section 3. Should any section, paragraph clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
