

TOWNSHIP OF WALL  
ORDINANCE NO. 1-2017

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 215-48 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE REGARDING SPEED RESTRICTIONS TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMIT FOR TILTONS CORNER ROAD TO 35 MILES PER HOUR FOR THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF THE ROADWAY**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Wall, through adoption of Wall Municipal Code Chapter 215-1 recognizes that Title 39, of the New Jersey Statutes, applies to certain roadways within the Township of Wall; and, that Wall Township has the prerogative to establish speed limits upon certain municipal roadways; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Wall, through adoption of Wall Municipal Code Chapter 215-19 recognizes that Wall Township has the prerogative to establish speed limits that shall apply in both directions and that such speed limits shall be memorialized in Wall Township Municipal Code Chapter 215-48; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Wall Township Chief of Police has conducted a traffic study and has determined that it is in the best interests of the residents of Wall Township to establish a speed limit along the entire length of Tilton's Corner Road to 35 miles per hour; and,

**NOW, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, in the State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter 215-48 Schedule XVI: Speed Limits, shall be amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 215-48 Schedule XVI: Speed Limits.

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Speed Limit</u>	<u>Limits</u>
Tilton's Corner Road	35 miles per hour	Along the entire length

**Section 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in such conflict or inconsistent.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance may be renumbered for codification purposes.

**Section 4.** In the event that any section, part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unenforceable or invalid by any court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so held unenforceable or invalid.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.
