

TOWNSHIP OF WALL

ORDINANCE NO. 9-2017

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 33, SECTION 33.12 OF THE WALL TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING INSURANCE AND OTHER BENEFITS FOR MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the Township Committee, through Chapter 33, Article I, Section 33.12, provides certain insurance and benefits for municipal employees; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes to amend these benefits by excluding elected public officials; and,

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, in the State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Insurance and other benefits is hereby amended as follows (new language is in bold and deleted language is stricken through):

33-12. Insurance and other benefits.

E. For the purposes of ~~this subsection~~ § 33-12, the term "full-time permanent employee" shall be ~~deemed to include~~ **exclude** elected public officials. Therefore, no such official shall be eligible for benefits under this section. ~~Insurance benefits for any such elected official shall terminate upon the expiration of the official's term of office.~~ Insurance benefits for all full-time permanent employees shall terminate upon the employee's separation from service, including a separation from service which occurs due to the employee's absence for any reason for a period in excess of six months, pursuant to § 33-6D (12) hereof.

**Section 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in such conflict or inconsistent.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance may be renumbered for codification purposes.

**Section 4.** In the event that any section, part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unenforceable or invalid by any court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so held unenforceable or invalid.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.
