Recognition Program to honor recipients in the private and agricultural sector that use strategies to reduce energy consumption and waste, use sustainable materials, offer greener products, and contribute to the local community. The WTEAC Green Team would like to reward and acknowledge companies and agricultural businesses that are leading the way in sustainable business practices.

The purpose of the Program is to recognize local businesses that make environmental improvements and contributions to the community in the following categories: Waste Management, Energy Use, Water Conservation, Green Building and Landscaping, Transportation, Pollution Reduction, Social Responsibility, Commitment to Local Economy, and Goals and Reporting Assessment.

The benefit is that your business will be awarded with a certificate presented to you by our Mayor and Environmental Committee. Your business will appear on our WallNj.com web site and hopefully your photo will appear in the "Coast Star" newspaper.



Energy efficiency and other sustainable practices frequently offer long-term cost savings, allowing businesses to contribute to the community while becoming more economically competitive. Green business practices can save money by providing green products and services.



A Green Business Recognition Program helps to promote the locality as a green community.

Communities with a green profile and high demand for sustainable products and services are better able to compete for new green jobs and sustainable industries.

Businesses and social enterprises can be change agents for healthy growth and revitalization. They can influence government to remove obstacles, create incentives, and provide support to create an economic environment that is restorative, equitable, and sustainable. Business actions ultimately influence public policy.

To become certified, applicants must complete the assessment check sheet application which includes 48 items in 9 categories. A minimum of 10 check mark actions is required and, in addition, the selection of whom to select is based on the narrative for entry into the program.



Award presentations are held at the Wall Township Municipal Complex where recipients will receive a certificate of certification, thus

becoming members of the Green Business Recognition Program.

Green business applications will be accepted annually and processed in July. New members will be recognized in August/September.

Applications can be obtained by visiting the official Wall Township web site under wallnj.com, government, boards and committees, environmental and downloading the forms under Green Business Recognition Program.
