

TOWNSHIP OF WALL

ORDINANCE NO. 4-2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 215-37 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE LIMITING THE GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING (GVWR) ON WATERVIEW WAY

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall, through adoption of Wall Municipal Code Chapter 215-1 recognizes that Title 39, of the New Jersey Statutes, applies to certain roadways within the Township of Wall; and, that Wall Township has the prerogative to establish gross vehicle weight ratings upon certain municipal roadways; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall, through adoption of Wall Municipal Code Chapter 215-10 recognizes that Wall Township has the prerogative to establish gross vehicle weight ratings upon certain municipal roadways; and, shall be memorialized in Wall Township Municipal Code Chapter 215-37; and,

WHEREAS, the Wall Township Chief of Police has conducted a traffic study and has determined that it is in the best interests of the residents of Wall Township to establish gross vehicle weight ratings upon certain municipal roadways; and,

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, in the State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 215-37 Schedule V: Trucks over 8,000 pounds GVWR Gross Vehicle Weight Rating, shall be amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 215-37 Schedule V:

Name of Street

Location

Waterview Way

Between Gully Road and Belmar Boulevard

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in such conflict or inconsistent.

Section 3. This Ordinance may be renumbered for codification purposes.



Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.


