“Environmental Community Outreach Award: *Wall Township Environmental Commission – Arbor Day/Earth Day Projects for Assisted Living Seniors -- Ongoing Project.* The WTEAC decided in 2016 to bring projects to elderly residents in assisted living facilities that are often overlooked and disregarded in terms of the environment. The 2016, 2017 and 2018 programs were hosted at assisted living facilities in the Township.
