The Wall Township Environmental Advisory Committee/Green Team sponsored an educational opportunity for 8th graders in their Science Lab, at the Wall Intermediate School on November 26, 2019 to learn about "The Importance of Wastewater Treatment in our Society." The presentation was given by Mr. Bob Fisher, Executive Director of the Bayshore Regional Sewerage Authority.

He educated the students on the community infrastructure of water, the wastewater treatment process and its relationship to clean, fresh water and conservation. The students were encouraged to enter an essay competition based on Mr. Fisher's presentation through a combination of hands-on demonstrations, PowerPoint, and interactive activities. Mr. Fisher explained the cycle of water on Earth and the five stages in wastewater treatment before being discharged back into the environment.




