RESOLUTION NO. 18-1227

**AUTHORIZING SUNESYS, LLC TO INSTALL FIBER
TELECOMMUNICATIONS FACILITIES ON EXISTING UTILITY POLES**

WHEREAS, Sunesys, LLC, a company with offices located at 202 Titus Avenue, Warrington, PA 18976, has previously contracted with the Township to utilize the municipal rights-of-way of the Township for the installation of certain fiber telecommunications systems, by agreement dated December 4, 2014, for an initial term of twenty (20) years (“Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides Sunesys, LLC with the right to place telecommunications facilities aerially on existing utility poles or in an underground conduit in the public rights-of-way within the Township of Wall; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that Sunesys, LLC may submit a modified or expanded occupancy application; and

WHEREAS, Sunesys, LLC requested municipal consent to install 0.24 aerial miles of its fiber telecommunications systems aerially on existing utility poles in the Township, along Allenwood Road, between Route 34 and 18th Avenue; and


WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that Sunesys, LLC will pay the Township a fee of \$1,500.00 for such subsequent applications; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Township of Wall and its citizens to grant consent to Sunesys, LLC and the Township has no reason to deny consent.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Sunesys, LLC is hereby authorized to install its fiber telecommunications systems on existing utility poles in the public rights-of-way of the Township of Wall on Allenwood Road, in accordance with the plans submitted by Sunesys, LLC, and Sunesys, LLC shall pay the Township \$1,500.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Township officials including, but not limited to the Mayor, Township Administrator, Municipal Clerk, are hereby authorized and directed to take such ministerial actions as are necessary to effectuate the provisions of this resolution.
