**AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUBMISSION OF THE NEW JERSEY
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL OR
TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Wall Township is applying for funding to conduct infrastructure/drainage improvements at the intersection of 17th Avenue and I Street along the school route for West Belmar School within the Township of Wall; and

WHEREAS, employees of the Wall Township Police Department, Wall Township Public Schools, Wall Township Department of Engineering and Planning, and Wall Township Administration Office have met and have identified this intersection as a difficult intersection for pedestrians and bicyclists to navigate due to ponding water; and


WHEREAS, it has been determined that improvements to this intersection to mitigate flooding and ponding of water will greatly improve pedestrian and bicycle safety for students of the West Belmar School; and

WHEREAS the project will help to continue and improve the promotion and encouragement of pedestrian and bicycle access and safety for school children and residents; and

WHEREAS, maintenance of the facility, once constructed, will be assumed by the Township of Wall with the exception of the following: (1) where local ordinances that places maintenance responsibility with each individual property owner; and (2) those crosswalks located on State or County Highways; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall that it hereby supports the submission of a grant application for the Safe Routes to School Program within the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation and authorizes the Mayor, Township Administrator and the Municipal Clerk to execute any and all documents necessary and related to the submission of said grant application or grant agreement
