RESOLUTION NO. 22-0615

AUTHORIZATION TO AWARD AN EMERGENCY CONTRACT UNDER NEW JERSEY LOCAL PUBLIC CONTRACTS LAW, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6, FOR THE DISPOSAL OF CONTAMINATED SOIL

WHEREAS, Township of Wall (“Township”) is the current owner of certain real property designated as Block 6, Lots 6, 7, and 12 on the Township of Wall’s tax map (“Property”); and,

WHEREAS, under Resolution No. 20-0141, Township of Wall designated Spano Partners Holdings (“Spano”) as the redeveloper for the Property and also authorized the Township to lease the Property to Spano for the proposed solar field on the Property; and,

WHEREAS, Spano’s professionals discovered the presence of contaminated soil on the Property, which is required to be removed immediately; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has determined that the contaminated soil is an imminent hazard; and,

WHEREAS, an emergency purchase pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 may be awarded without advertisement for bids or bidding in that an emergency affecting the health and public safety requires the immediate performance of the service; and,


WHEREAS, there is the need for emergency disposal of the contaminated soil as stated by the Township Engineer. Therefore, such contract may be awarded without competitive bidding as permitted by N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6; and

WHEREAS, the Township received a proposal from Envirotactics for the removal of the contaminated soil under New Jersey environmental rules and regulations and awards Envirotactics in the amount of thirty-three thousand one-hundred seventy dollar(s) (\$33,170.00). and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall as follows:

1. The Township Committee authorizes the contract for the removal of contaminated soil at a price not to exceed \$33,170.00 (thirty-three thousand one-hundred seventy dollars) with Envirotactics
2. This resolution is subject to the filing of a certification from the CFO as to the availability of funds per N.J.A.C.5:30-5.3 (a).
3. The Mayor, Municipal Clerk and any other applicable Township officers or employees are hereby authorized and directed to take such ministerial actions as are necessary to effectuate the terms of this resolution.
