

TOWNSHIP OF WALL

ORDINANCE NO. 28 -2002

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 9-2002, ADOPTED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE ON FEBRUARY 13, 2002, FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL.

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2002, the Township Committee adopted Ordinance No. 9-2002, which fixed the compensation of officers and employees of the Township of Wall; and

WHEREAS, the salaries listed for certain positions in Group VII need to be amended to reflect contractual increases;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 9-2002, adopted by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on February 13, 2002, be and the same is hereby amended to reflect the following:

GROUP VII	POLICE OFFICERS
"- Captain	101,764.72
- Lieutenant	94,665.16
- Sergeant	88,060.24
- Corporal	81,916.55"

Section 2. All ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such

inconsistency.

Section 3. Should any section, paragraph, clause or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law, retroactive to January 1, 2002.
