

TOWNSHIP OF WALL

ORDINANCE NO. 15 - 2001

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER II, "ADMINISTRATION", OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977", AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED PERTAINING TO EXTRA DUTY POLICE ASSIGNMENTS FOR TRAFFIC SAFETY AND SECURITY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey that:

Section 1. Chapter II, "Administration", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977" as amended and supplemented, be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented by the addition thereto of Section 2-18 entitled "Extra Duty Police Assignments for Traffic Safety and Security" to read, in full, as follows.

"2-8 EXTRA DUTY POLICE ASSIGNMENTS FOR TRAFFIC SAFETY AND SECURITY.

2-8.1 Advance Requests. All requests for extra duty assignments of police officers for traffic safety and security at construction sites, special events and other locations within the Township of Wall shall be made in writing to the chief of police before the first day such police services commence. In case of unforeseen emergencies, written requests shall be made as soon as practicable. All requests shall include a traffic safety plan for review by the chief of police. The chief of police may require revisions to the plan before approval of the extra duty assignments. Extra duty assignments of police personnel made by the chief of police shall not violate the terms of any applicable collective bargaining agreement.

2-8.2 Deposit Required. The person or entity requesting such police services shall deposit with the township cash, a bank check or money order in the amount of \$500.00 for each day such services are requested. All payments shall be made payable to the "Township of Wall". No police personnel will be provided unless the required amounts are prepaid and the traffic safety plan is approved by the chief of

police in advance of the commencement of such police services.

2-8.3 Escrow Fund Established. All funds for such police services will be placed in a Extra Duty Assignment Police Services fund which shall be established in the annual budget as a dedicated rider trust fund. As soon as the police services are provided to the requesting person or entity, the funds may be withdrawn to reimburse the township to ensure the timely payment of wages of the police officers as well as all administrative costs to the township.

2-8.4 Minimum Escrow Deposits. For those persons or entities which require continuous police services for a week or longer, a minimum balance of the average weekly costs shall be maintained in the escrow account. For those persons or entities which require continuous or frequent service, a deposit of \$500.00 shall be maintained in the escrow account for emergencies. Failure to maintain this minimum balance shall result in the termination of such police services until the escrow balance is replenished to the minimum balance.

2-8.5 Rates Established. The rates to be charged for such extra duty police services shall be as follows:

- a. \$35.00 per hour for wages.
- b. \$13.10 per hour for administrative costs."

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. Should any section, paragraph, clause or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on April 11, 2001, and further be considered for final passage and adopted at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey on May 9, 2001, at 8:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, Town Hall, to members of the general public who shall request the same.
