

TOWNSHIP OF WALL
ORDINANCE NO. 24 - 2001

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER IX ENTITLED "STREETS AND SIDEWALKS" OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977" AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, PERTAINING TO STREET OPENING PERMITS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter IX, "Streets and Sidewalks", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented. Section 9-1, "Excavation of Streets", Subsection 9-1.1 entitled "Permit Required", is hereby amended and supplemented and shall read as follows:

9-1.1 Permit Required.

No person, firm, corporation or public utility company shall dig up any street or public place without first having obtained a permit therefore as provided in this section.

No permits shall be issued for any excavation in a street which has been resurfaced by or on behalf of the township for a period of five (5) years from the date of the acceptance by the township of the resurfacing work. The township clerk shall maintain a list of all public streets resurfaced by, on behalf of, or at the direction of the township within the five (5) years immediately preceding the date of adoption of this Ordinance and shall supplement the list of resurfaced streets as required. The list shall contain the name of each street which is resurfaced; the portion or portions of the street which have been resurfaced and the date of acceptance of the resurfacing improvements by the township. The township clerk shall deny any application for a permit to excavate any street or portion thereof which has been resurfaced within the five (5) year period preceding the date of such application.

Section 2. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the

extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on May 9, 2001 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the all Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey, on June 13, 2001 at 8:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to, and up to and including, the date of such meeting, copies of said ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's office in the Township of Wall Town Hall to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
