

**TOWNSHIP OF WALL**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 3-2000**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER II, "ADMINISTRATION," SECTION 2-4, "PERSONNEL POLICIES", AND SUBSECTION 2-4.3 "GENERAL EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES", OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977", AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter II, "Administration", section 2-4, "Personnel Policies", subsection 2-4.3, "General Employment Practices", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented by the deletion therefrom of subparagraph 2-4i., and the substitution therefor of the following:

"i. *Probationary Service.* Except where statutory requirements direct otherwise, all new employees, except those covered by collective bargaining agreements, shall serve a period of probation of a minimum of 90 days. All full time employees shall be entitled to insurance and sick leave benefits commencing on the first day of the month following the first 30 days of employment. All full time employees shall be entitled to the other personnel benefits of this Chapter commencing on the 31st day of employment."

Section 2. Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 3. All Ordinances, or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of

this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance will take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on February 9, 2000, and will further be considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey on March 8, 2000, at 8:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, Town Hall, to members of the general public who shall request the same.
