

**TOWNSHIP OF WALL****ORDINANCE NO. 6 - 2000****AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL CREATING THE OFFICE OF DEPUTY TOWNSHIP CLERK.**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter II, "Administration", Section 2-2, "Administrative Offices", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented by the addition thereto of the following subsection:

"2-2.12 Deputy Township Clerk. There is hereby established in the township the position of deputy township clerk pursuant to the provisions of this subsection and the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:9-135.

- a. Term. The initial term of office of the deputy township clerk shall be from January 4, 2000 to December 31, 2000. Thereafter the deputy township clerk shall be appointed by the Township Committee for a term of one year from January 1 in the year of the appointment until a successor has been appointed and qualified.
- b. Functions and Duties. The deputy township clerk shall assist the township clerk in the performance of the clerk's statutory duties. During the absence or disability of the township clerk, the deputy township clerk shall have all the powers of the township clerk and shall perform the functions and duties of such office.
- c. Compensation. The deputy township clerk shall receive such compensation as shall be fixed by the general salary ordinance of the township."

**Section 2.** All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

**Section 3.** Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not effect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law, retroactive to January 4, 2000.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on February 9, 2000 and will further be considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey, on March 8, 2000, at 8:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, Town Hall, to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
