

**TOWNSHIP OF WALL**

**ORDINANCE NO. 17 - 2000**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SCHEDULE XIII (NO LEFT TURN), OF SECTION 7-10.1 (LEFT TURN PROHIBITIONS), OF CHAPTER VIII "TRAFFIC" OF THE "REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL 1977" AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED.**

**WHEREAS**, the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977, as amended and supplemented, Section 7-10.1 provides that no person shall make a left hand turn at any of the locations described in Schedule XIII attached to and made a part of this Chapter;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter XIII, "Traffic", Section 7-10.1, "Left Turn Prohibitions", Schedule XIII "No Left Turn" of the "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977" as amended and supplemented, be and is hereby further amended and supplemented by the addition thereto of the following locations at which a left turn is prohibited:

<u>Location</u>	<u>Direction</u>	<u>Prohibited</u>
"Wyckoff Road and Driveway entrance to Block 912, Lots 3 & 4	Northbound on Wyckoff Road	No left turn."

Section 2. The prohibition on left hand turns in and out of the Wyckoff Road driveaway into Block 912, Lots 3 and 4 will automatically expire upon the full completion of the Wyckoff Road improvements including the installation of a left hand turn lane on

Wyckoff Road at the site driveway which will provide a left hand turn lane on Wyckoff Road for vehicles turning into Block 912, Lots 3 and 4.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. Should any section, paragraph, clause or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on June 14, 2000, and further be considered for final passage and adopted at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey on July 12, 2000, at 8:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, Town Hall, to members of the general public who shall request the same.
