

## TOWNSHIP OF WALL

## ORDINANCE NO. 25 - 1999

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SECTION 2-4.11, "RETIREMENT," OF CHAPTER II, "ADMINISTRATION," OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977," AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, PERTAINING TO RETIREMENT FOR POLICE OFFICERS.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Chapter II, "Administration", Section 2-4, "Personnel Policies", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, and more particularly subsection 2-4.11 thereof entitled, "Retirement", be and the same is hereby amended to delete therefrom paragraph 2-4.11f. pertaining to the purchase of credit for prior military service.

Section 2. Chapter II, "Administration", Section 2-4, "Personnel Policies", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, subsection 2-4.11, "Retirement", be and the same is hereby amended to change the designation of subparagraph 2-4.11g. to 2-4.11f.

Section 3. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 4. Should any Section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance by a Court of competent jurisdiction be deemed invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective one hundred eighty (180) days following its passage and publication according to law.
