

TOWNSHIP OF WALL
ORDINANCE NO. 27-1998

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$120,000.00 FROM EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SERVICES TRUST FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN AMBULANCE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES EQUIPMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township Committee of the Township of Wall in the County of Monmouth, the State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The sum of One Hundred Twenty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$120,000.00) presently held in the Emergency Management Services Trust be and is hereby appropriated for the purchase of an ambulance and emergency services equipment.

Section 2. In connection with the amount authorized in Section 1 hereof, the Township makes the following determinations:

A. The purpose described in Section thereof is not a current expense and is an improvement which the Township of Wall may lawfully make as a general improvement.

B. The period of usefulness of the purpose described in Section 1 hereof, according to the Local Bond Law and according to the reasonable life thereof is ten (10) years.

Section 3. The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this appropriation ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency or amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended

capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 4. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication as provided by law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on September 9, 1998 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey, on October 14, 1998 at 8:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to, and up to and including, the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's office in the Township of Wall Town Hall to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
