

TOWNSHIP OF WALL**ORDINANCE NO. 11 - 1998**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER I, "GENERAL" OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977", SECTION 1-5, PERTAINING TO THE SEAL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL.

WHEREAS, "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", do not presently provide for a regulation of the use of the Township seal; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee finds that the use of the Township seal shall be prohibited without a license and approval of the Township Committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter I, "General", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, Section 1-5, "Seal of the Township" of Wall be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented by the addition thereto of the following subsection:

"1-5.1 Requirement of License for Use of Township Seal

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to use the Township seal without first obtaining a license from the Township.

(b) The township clerk shall prepare an appropriate application form which prospective applicants shall complete and submit to the township committee for its consideration.

(c) The Township Committee shall consider such a request and, if approved by the Township Committee, then, in that event, an applicant will be allowed

limited use of the Township seal for the consideration of \$1.00 dollar per year.

(d) The issuance of a license shall permit the licensee to use the Township seal in a specified publication, document or website. An appropriate description of its identity as the official seal of the Township of Wall shall accompany the seal. An informative historical description of the significance of the seal may be provided with the use of the seal by an applicant.

"1-5.2 Prohibition of Use of Township Seal Absent Appropriate Disclaimer"

(a) Notwithstanding the grant of a license, any person utilizing the Township seal pursuant to this section, shall incorporate a disclaimer as promulgated by the township clerk."

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on April 8, 1998 and will further be considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey, on May 13, 1998 at 8:00 o'clock p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at

which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township Town Hall to the members of the general public who shall request same.
