

TOWNSHIP OF WALL**ORDINANCE NO. 22 - 1996**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SCHEDULE I, "NO PARKING", OF SECTION 7-3.3, "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS", OF CHAPTER VII, "TRAFFIC", OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977", AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, PERTAINING TO A PARKING PROHIBITION ON OLD MILL ROAD; AND AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SCHEDULE XIV, "NO U-TURN", OF SECTION 7-10.2, "U-TURN PROHIBITION", OF CHAPTER VII, "TRAFFIC", OF THE "REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977", AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, PERTAINING TO A U-TURN PROHIBITION ON RAMSHORN DRIVE.

WHEREAS, "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, Section 7-3.3, "Parking Prohibited At All Times on Certain Streets", provides that: "No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts thereof described in Schedule I attached to and made a part of this Chapter"; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has recommended an addition to the streets included in Schedule I; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee finds that parking should be prohibited at all times on the eastern side of Old Mill Road from the Spring Lake boundary to West Chicago Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, Section 7-10.2, "U-Turn Prohibition", provides that: "No persons shall make a u-turn at any of the locations described in Schedule XIV attached and made a part of this Chapter."; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has recommended an addition to the
