

**TOWNSHIP OF WALL**

**ORDINANCE NO. 23 - 1995**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER III, "REGULATORY ORDINANCES", ARTICLE 3-12, "DUMPING OF GARBAGE AND TRASH", AND ARTICLE 3-13, "MANDATORY RECYCLING", OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977", AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, PERTAINING TO THE COLLECTION OF BRANCHES, CLIPPINGS AND LEAVES AND NONRESIDENTIAL RECYCLING.**

Section 1. Chapter III, "Regulatory Ordinances", Article 3-7, "Collection of garbage and refuse", Section 3-7.3, "Preparation for Collection", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", be and the same is hereby amended and supplemented by the deletion therefrom of subparagraph 3-7.3e. and the substitution therefor of the following:

"e. Branches, clippings and leaves.

1. Tree banches and hedge clippings shall be cut to a maximum length of four feet and shall be placed at the curb with butt ends placed toward the roadside in a neat and orderly fashion. No viney material, prunings, or leaves may be mixed with branches. Pickup will be between such dates as may be designated for such pickup and branches and clippings shall be placed at the curb only within the dates and times established by regulations promulgated by the township.

2. Leaves shall be loosely piled in a neat and orderly fashion, free of any other vegetative material, such as vines, prunings or grass, between the curb and sidewalk area for collection by township vehicles between such dates as may be designated for such pickup by regulations promulgated by the township. Leaves in bags shall not be collected".

Section 2. Chapter III, "Regulatory Ordinances", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, Article 3-13, "Mandatory Recycling" be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented by the deletion therefrom of Section 3-13.3, "Commercial and Industrial Recycling" and the substitution therefor of the following:

“3-13.3 Commercial and Industrial Recycling.

Commencing April 1, 1988 all persons who occupy commercial, Industrial, institutional, governmental premises, both private and public, including owners, lessess, tenants or licensee, shall separate the following types of solid waste produced by such premises, for collection and recycling by a private hauler:

- a. Leaves.
- b. Glass bottles and jars.
- c. Aluminum.
- d. Corrugated cardboard.
- e. High grade paper.
- f. Tin and bimetal cans.
- g. Newspapers.”

Section 3. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remiander of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

### NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on September 13, 1995 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall Township, New Jersey, on September 27, 1995 at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given

an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, to the members of the general public who shall request same.
