

TOWNSHIP OF WALL

ORDINANCE NO. 34-1995

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL TO VACATE ALL THE PUBLIC RIGHTS AND EASEMENTS IN A PORTION OF THAT STREET KNOWN AS CEDAR LANE.

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest will best be served by releasing and vacating the public rights and easements in a portion of that street known as Cedar Lane, which is bordered by Lots 1 and 5 in Block 107 and Lots 2 and 3 in Block 104 as shown on the current Tax Map of the Township of Wall;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby vacated, released and extinguished all of the public rights and easements in and to a portion of that street known as Cedar Lane lying in the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, which street is shown and designated on a map entitled "Map of Belmar Gardens" filed in the Monmouth County Clerk's Office on June 24, 1927 as Case 21, Sheet 22 and is more particularly described as follows:

Being all of that portion of Cedar Lane lying southwardly of the southerly right of way line of Maple Street as shown on the Tax Map of the Township of Wall, and as also shown on a map entitled, "Map of Belmar Gardens", filed in the Monmouth County Clerk's Office on June 24, 1927 as Case 21, Sheet 22 and extending southwardly from the aforesaid southerly right of way line of Maple Street to the northerly right of way line of Beverly Street for a distance of 200.98 feet, said Cedar Lane being approximately ten (10) feet in width.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.

NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on December 13, 1995 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New

Jersey on December 27, 1995 at 8:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to, and up to and including, the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's office in the Township of Wall Town Hall to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
