ordinance no. 39 - 1991

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER II, "ADMINISTRATION", OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977", AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, SECTION 2-4.12, "INSURANCE AND OTHER BENEFITS", PERTAINING TO MEDICAL INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR RETIRED EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, in the County of Monmouth and the State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Chapter II, "Administration", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, Section 2-4.12, "Insurance and Other Benefits", Subsection 2-4.12c., "Medical Insurance for Retired Employees", subparagraph 2-4.12c.1., "Eligible Employees", be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented by the addition thereto of the following additional subparagraph, which shall constitute subparagraph 2-4.12c.1.(a):

"(a) Upon retirement, each full-time permanent employee hired prior to January 1, 1991, who is not covered by a collective bargaining agreement with the Township, and who has been employed by the Township for at least 25 years in a full-time, permanent capacity and who is eligible for retirement under the Public Employees Retirement System, shall be entitled to continue to be enrolled in the family medical insurance plan provided to Township employees, at

no cost to the employee, subject to the provisions of subparagraph 4 hereof and provided further that the employee submits a notification of retirement on or before July 1, 1992."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.

Section 3. Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All Ordinances, or parts, thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
