

TOWNSHIP OF WALL

ORDINANCE NO. 49 - 1990

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE WALL YOUTH CENTER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1, et seq., BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AND THE WALL TOWNSHIP, SEA GIRT, AND SPRING LAKE BOARDS OF EDUCATION.

WHEREAS, the Wall Youth Center provides counselling and educational programs in the area of substance abuse; and

WHEREAS, the Boards of Education of Sea Girt and Spring Lake are desirous of retaining the services of the Wall Youth Center to present various educational programs to their students and staff pertaining to substance abuse; and the Wall Township Board of Education requires the temporary use of the Youth Center building as an alternative school location; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1, et seq., agreements should be prepared to govern the rights and obligations of the Wall Youth Center and the Spring Lake and Sea Girt Boards of Education in connection with such educational programs; and the use of the Youth Center as an alternative school;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Director of the Wall Youth Center be and is hereby authorized to execute Interlocal Services Agreements pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:8A-11, et seq. between the Township of Wall and the Wall Township, Sea Girt and Spring Lake Boards of Education for the purpose of providing educational programs in substance abuse to students and staff at the Sea Girt and Spring

Lake Elementary Schools during the 1990-1991 school year and with the Wall Township Board of Education for the use of the Youth Center as an alternate school. Copies of said agreements shall be maintained on file in the Township Clerk's office for public inspection.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.

Section 3. Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All Ordinances, or parts, thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on October 24, 1990 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey, on 11/28/90 at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to, and up to and including, the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's office in the Township of Wall Town Hall to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
