

TOWNSHIP OF WALL
ORDINANCE NO. 1 - 1990

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 5-8, "POLICE TOWING OPERATORS" OF CHAPTER V, "GENERAL LICENSING", OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977", AND FURTHER REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 20-1989 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL PERTAINING TO THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF THE TOWING OF DISABLED VEHICLES.

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on April 26, 1989, adopted Ordinance No. 20-1989, which Ordinance enacted Section 5-8, "Police Towing Operators" of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall", pertaining to the licensing and regulation of the towing of disabled vehicles when necessary to safeguard the public health, safety and welfare within the Township; and

WHEREAS, in September, 1989, the Attorney General of the State of New Jersey issued a formal opinion specifying the manner in which towing services are to be provided to Municipal Police Departments, which opinion provided for the public advertisement for bids for the provision of such services; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee finds that the aforesaid Ordinance has been rendered unnecessary and inappropriate and should, therefore, be repealed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth and State of New

Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter V, "General Licensing" of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, be and the same is hereby further amended to delete therefrom Section 5-8, "Police Towing Operators", in its entirety.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 20-1989 of the Township of Wall, finally adopted on April 26, 1989, be and the same is hereby repealed, in its entirety.

Section 3. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. Should any section, paragraph, clause, or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on Jan. 10, 1990 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the Court Room, Police Headquarters Building, Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey, on Jan. 24, 1990 at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to, and up to and including, the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's office in the Township of Wall Town Hall to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
