

## TOWNSHIP OF WALL

ORDINANCE NO. 41 - 1988

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE ALL THE PUBLIC RIGHTS AND EASEMENTS  
IN A PORTION OF THAT STREET KNOWN AS MEETINGHOUSE ROAD.

WHEREAS, a Resolution was passed by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall authorizing the execution of a Consent Order in the case Justini vs. Township of Wall, et als, Docket No. L-027255-87; and

WHEREAS, it appears that pursuant to said Consent Order the public interest will best be served by releasing and vacating the public rights and easements which may exist, if any, in a portion of that road known as Meetinghouse Road which is between Lakewood Road and Church Street; and

WHEREAS, the parties requesting said vacation have consented to pay all legal, engineering and publication costs of the Township of Wall in accomplishing said vacation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby vacated, released and extinguished all of the public rights and easements which may exist, if any, in and to a portion of that street known as Meetinghouse

Road lying in the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey which is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the centerline of Meetinghouse Road at its intersection with the northerly line of Lakewood Road and from said point of beginning running thence northerly, northeasterly, and easterly along the various courses of said Meetinghouse Road, 2,120 feet more or less to the southerly line of Church Street near its intersection with West Church Street and thereto end.

The above description is intended to encompass that portion of Meetinghouse Road from the northerly line of Lakewood Road to the southerly line of Church Street in its entirety.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.

#### NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on Oct. 26, 1988 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Wall at the Municipal Courtroom, Police Headquarters Building, Allaire Road, Township of Wall, on Nov. 9, 1988 at 8 P.M. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the Agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, Township Hall, to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
