

TOWNSHIP OF WALL

ORDINANCE NO. 42 - 1988

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE WALL YOUTH CENTER TO EXECUTE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1, ET SEQ., BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AND THE SEA GIRL BOARD OF EDUCATION ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, THE SPRING LAKE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND ST. CATHERINE'S ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the Wall Youth Center provides counseling and educational programs in the area of substance abuse; and

WHEREAS, the Sea Girt Elementary School, the H.W. Mountz Elementary School of Spring Lake and St. Catherine's Elementary School are desirous of retaining the services of the Wall Youth Center to present various educational programs to their students and staff pertaining to substance abuse; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1, et seq., agreements should be prepared to govern the rights and obligations of the Wall Youth Center and the other parties involved in connection with such educational programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Director of the Wall Youth Center be and is hereby authorized to execute Interlocal Services Agreements pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1, et seq. between the Township

of Wall and the Sea Girt and Spring Lake Boards of Education and St. Catherine's Elementary School for the purpose of providing educational programs in substance abuse to students and staff at their schools during the 1988 - 1989 school year. Copies of said Agreements are on file in the Township Clerk's Office and are available for public inspection.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law, retroactive to September 1, 1988.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on Oct. 26, 1988 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Wall at the Municipal Courtroom, Police Headquarters Building, Allaire Road, Township of Wall, on Nov. 9, 1988 at 8 P.M. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the Agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, Township Hall, to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
