RESOLUTION NO. 22-1010

**AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUBMISSION OF THE RECYCLING TONNAGE
GRANT APPLICATION FOR 2022 TO THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

WHEREAS, the Recycling Act P.L., 1981, c. 278, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grants may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intent and spirit of the Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue and expand existing programs; and,

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Energy has promulgated recycling regulations, N.J.A.C. 14A: 6-1 et. seq. to implement the Recycling Act; and,


WHEREAS, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants including, but not limited to, making and keeping accurate verifiable records concerning the amount of eligible recyclable materials collected and claimed by the municipality; and,

WHEREAS, a resolution authorizing the Township to apply for such tonnage grants, will memorialize the Township's commitment to recycling and indicate the assent of the Township Committee to such efforts and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and associated recycling regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall that the Municipal Recycling Tonnage Grant Application to the New Jersey Department of Energy, Office of Recycling be submitted and the same is hereby authorized and endorsed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Lawrence Leming be and is hereby designated to file said application and to serve as the Township's Coordinator with respect to recycling programs and regulations.
