ORDINANCE NO. 12-2015

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING THE CODES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, CHAPTER 175 RECORDS, INSPECTION AND REPRODUCTIONS

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall requires that certain fees shall be paid to offset the costs of production and processing of certain governmental records that are regularly requested by members of the public; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 175- 4 Fees for reproduction of certified records is hereby amended as follows:

- A. The request for certified copies of all marriage or civil union certificates, birth certificates, death certificates and domestic partnership certificates shall be \$20 per certificate. The fee for processing corrective form REG. 34 in the following instances shall be \$20: addition of father's name as a result of paternity action; correction of false information or incorrect information given on any government record. The \$20 fee will be waived in cases where error was caused by a Registrar of Vital Statistics.
- **B**. The fee for certification for burial permits shall be set at \$5 (five dollars) or up to the limits established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 26:6-17.
- **C.** In cases where Wall Township's Mayor performs marriage, civil union, or domestic partnership ceremonies for a Wall Township resident, the \$20 fee shall be waived for the cost of the first copy of the certificate.
- <u>Section 2</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in such conflict or inconsistent.

Section 3. This Ordinance may be renumbered for codification purposes.

<u>Section 4.</u> In the event that any section, part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unenforceable or invalid by any court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so held unenforceable or invalid.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after passage and publication as provided by law.
