To become Sustainable Jersey certified, Wall Township had to complete a balance of rigorous program of sustainability actions.

The Wall Township Environmental Committee Green Team completed 20 actions, which included 2 priority actions in 8 categories, for a total of 200 points.

Why Get Certified

The Sustainable Jersey actions cover a wide range of topic areas focusing on people, prosperity, and the planet.

Registered towns get special priority access and notification of incentives and grants, and they are eligible for the Sustainable Jersey Small Grants Program.

The program helps communities improve efficiency, cut waste, and stimulate their local economies.

Sustainable Jersey provides tools and resources which include regular training workshops, webinars and leadership meetings on important municipal issues.

After being certified, Sustainable Jersey towns are promoted on Sustainable Jersey's website, in their publications, in the media, and at promotional events.
