RESOLUTION NO. 19-0312

**AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL TO ENTER INTO AN
EMERGENCY INTERCONNECTION OPERATING AGREEMENT WITH THE
BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN**

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall and the Borough of Manasquan wish to enter into an Emergency Interconnection Operating Agreement to memorialize their intent to share water supply in emergency situations; and,

WHEREAS, the Water Supply Management Act Regulations, N.J.A.C 7:19-6 et seq., require written agreements between water purveyors and requires that such agreements are filed with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection; and,

WHEREAS, there currently exist interconnections between the two water systems at the following municipal border locations: Atlantic Avenue, Church Street, corner of Narrumson Road and Lenape Terrace; and,


WHEREAS, the municipalities of Wall and Manasquan will share the cost of maintenance for the meter pits and the meters and in emergency situations each municipality shall be charged a reduced rate for water use from the other municipality; and,

WHEREAS, the Wall Township Municipal Clerk shall file an executed copy of this agreement with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth, New Jersey that authorization is herewith provided to execute an agreement with the Borough of Manasquan for emergency water supply; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Wall Township officials are herewith authorized to take such ministerial actions as are necessary to effectuate the goals of this Resolution.
