RESOLUTION NO. 19-0416

AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH DEE-EN ELECTRICAL CONTRACTING FOR THE EMERGENCY GENERATORS AT MUNICIPAL FACILITIES AT A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$883,815.00

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5 et seq., the Local Public Contract Law, the Township Committee previously authorized the advertisement for the receipt of bids for Emergency Generators at Municipal Facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall will benefit by having received a FEMA grant in the amount of \$329,00.00 which will be used by the Township to offset the costs of this bid award; and,

WHEREAS, on Friday, April 5, 2019, the Township received seven (7) proposals; the top three lowest responsive bidders are identified as follows:


WHEREAS, Matthew Zahorsky, Township Engineer, and Roberts Engineering Group, recommended to the Township Committee the contract be awarded to Dee-en Electrical Consulting; and

WHEREAS, the Township Attorney reviewed the bid of Dee-en Electrical Consulting and found the same to be legally sufficient; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall as follows:

1. The Township Committee hereby concurs in the recommendation of Matthew Zahorsky, Township Engineer, and Roberts Engineering Group, the appointed consulting engineers for the Township of Wall and hereby awards the contract for Emergency Generators at Municipal Facilities to Dee-en Electrical Consulting at a price not to exceed \$883,815.00 (eight hundred eighty-three thousand eight hundred fifteen dollars and zero cents)
2. This resolution is subject to the filing of certification from the CFO as to the availability of funds per N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.3 (a).
3. The Mayor, Municipal Clerk, and any other applicable Township officers or employees are hereby authorized and directed to take such ministerial actions as are necessary to effectuate the terms of this resolution.
