

**TOWNSHIP OF WALL**  
**RESOLUTION NO. 19-1114**

**AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE A CHANGE ORDER FOR  
IMPROVEMENTS TO RAMSHORN DRIVE PHASE V FOR A NET CHANGE  
DECREASE OF \$32,974.31**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Wall and Earle Asphalt Company are parties to a contract for the improvements to Ramshorn Drive phase V in an original amount of \$312,713.13 (three hundred twelve thousand seven hundred thirteen dollars and thirteen cents); and

**WHEREAS**, Earle Asphalt Company, submitted Change Order No. 1, a reduction, in the amount of \$32,974.31 (thirty-two thousand nine-hundred seventy-four dollars and thirty-one cents); and


**WHEREAS**, the Township's Engineer, Matthew Zahorsky has reviewed the project and Change Order No. 1 and recommends that the Township execute Change Order No. 1 in an amount of \$32,974.31 (thirty-two thousand nine-hundred seventy-four dollars and thirty-one cents); and

**WHEREAS**, the total new contract price shall be \$279,738.82 (two hundred seventy-nine thousand seven hundred thirty-eight dollars and eighty-two cents) after Change Order No. 1 has been accepted and executed by the Township; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth, New Jersey that Change Order No. 1 - in an amount of \$32,974.31 (thirty-two thousand nine-hundred seventy-four dollars and thirty-one cents) for the contract between the Township of Wall and Earle Asphalt Company for improvements to Ramshorn Drive phase V be executed thereby reducing the new total contract price for the project to be \$279,738.82 (two hundred seventy-nine thousand seven hundred thirty-eight dollars and eighty-two cents).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that all Township officials including, but not limited to, the Mayor, Township Director of Engineering and Planning, and the Municipal Clerk, are hereby authorized and directed to take such ministerial actions as are necessary to effectuate the provisions of this resolution.
