

**TOWNSHIP OF WALL**

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-0413**

**AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL TO EXECUTE A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE HEIGHTS FOR THE PROVISION OF MAINTENANCE OF AN INTER-CONNECTION BETWEEN THE TWO MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEMS AND FOR MUTUAL WATER CONSUMPTION**

**WHEREAS**, The Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et Seq., authorizes local units as defined in said Act to enter into joint agreements for the provision of government services; and

**WHEREAS**, the “Water Supply Management Act” rules, N.J.A.C. 7:19-6 et. Seq. requires written agreements be entered into establishing procedures for the maintenance and use of water interconnections; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Township of Wall desires to enter into a shared services agreement with the Borough of Spring Lake Heights for the provision of maintaining an inter-connection device which is currently located at the intersection of Old Mill Road and Warren Avenue between the two water systems; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Spring Lake Heights and the Township of Wall will be responsible for the cost of maintaining that portion of the inter-connection equipment which is located within that municipality’s territory; and,


**WHEREAS**, Wall Township agrees also to pay Spring Lake Heights for the consumption of water coming from the Spring Lake Heights system and Spring Lake Heights agrees to pay Wall Township for water from the Wall Township system; and,

**WHEREAS**, the shared services agreement between Wall Township and the Borough of Spring Lake Heights will not obligate Wall Township to pay for any costs for the term of the agreement unless Wall Township consumes water from the Spring Lake Heights reserves; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth, New Jersey that the Township of Wall is authorized to enter into a contract as described above with the Borough of Spring Lake Heights; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all Township officials including, but not limited to the Mayor, the Township Administrator and the Municipal Clerk, are hereby authorized and directed to take such ministerial actions as are necessary to effectuate the provisions of this resolution.
